Welcome back to school! As we start a new calendar year. We need to review a few items:

The 2009-10, Open Enrollment Lottery Window is now open. The first enrollment window will close on February 15th. This window is the best opportunity for families desiring enrollment for the next school year. Please remember, if you have a student currently enrolled at NDPA, they do not need to re-enter the lottery process. All siblings you list, living in your household will be given preference to new enrollees. Forms for re-commitment to NDPA will come home January 16th. The lottery is only for NEW families seeking enrollment opportunity. We invite you to encourage your family and friends to apply.

Monday, January 19 - NO SCHOOL. It is the Martin Luther King day holiday.

Thursday, January 22nd, is our 5th Grade Maturation program. A parent meeting is scheduled for interested 5th grade parents on Thursday, January 15th in the 5-9 Building. Additional information will come home with your student next week.

Parent teacher conferences are right around the corner. Parent preference forms will be headed home with your student and posted on the website soon. Please be prompt in their return. Conference dates are: Feb 4th and 5th with NO SCHOOL on the 6th.

Please review with your students the NDPA Uniform Policy. It is posted on the website. Uniforms must be in compliance during school classes. All jackets, sweaters and items for warmth need to be removed during class unless they comply with our uniform code. They are allowed to wear them out to recess. All items are expected to be clean and in good repair. Friday's we allow the wearing of blue jeans

however, they must represent the standard of dress expected at NDPA.

Students are expected to wait outside the buildings prior to the start of school unless accompanied by a parent or have a pre-scheduled teacher or administrative appointment. All students are expected to enter the playgrounds until the start of school. The supervised school day is 8:15am to the end of the school day or afterschool activity. ALL students need to be promptly picked up at the end of the day or activity.

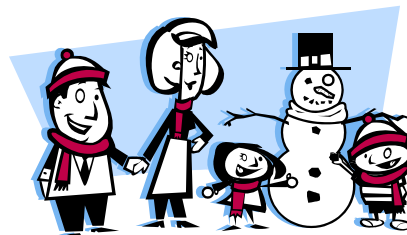
