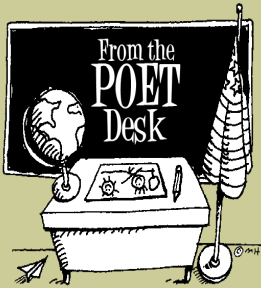


## 1-6 GRADE MUSIC CLASS CONCERTS ANNOUNCED!
