APPLICATION DEAD LINE IS FAST APPROACHING FOR 2009-2010 POET BOARD!

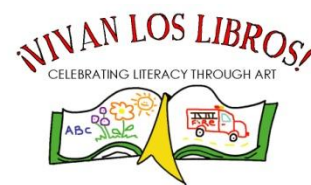
