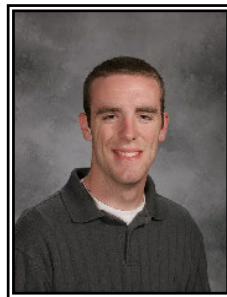


### Kim Mary Wood
