#### KINDERGARTEN ASSESSMENT SCREENINGS ARE JUST AROUND THE CORNER.

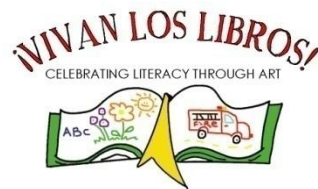

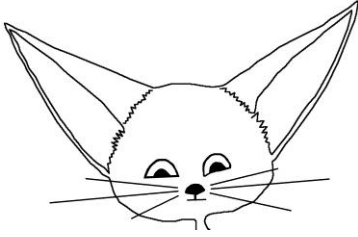


#### VIVAN LOS LIBROS! - NDPA's 4th Annual Art Auction

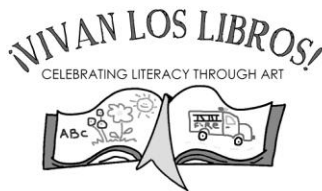
