DOES YOUR STUDENT OWE FOR A BOOK?

Parents,

We have an unusual percentage of books not returned to our school classrooms and libraries. Please check with your student today for any notice coming home to you regarding possible lost and damaged library or classroom text books which have not been returned with the approved student fines accessed.

Please help us keep NDPA's expense and effort to a minimum by working with both the school and your student as to the resolve of this student stewardship.

Our school policy on books states:

- Lost book: Student will be charged the replacement fee.
- Damaged: Student will be charged the replacement fee.
- Damaged/Usable: Student will be charged a Percentage of the replacement fee.
- Yearbook Penalty: Yearbooks will not be issued to students who have outstanding book fines.
