ups (\$5 activity fee to NDPA) are being accepted by Coach Dooley.

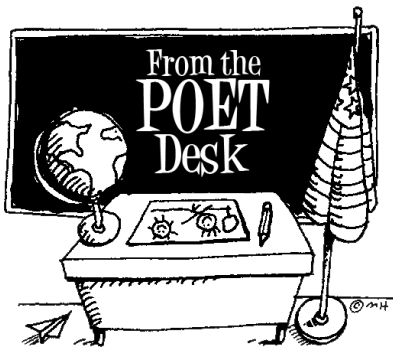

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

UPCOMING POET MEETING

The POET meeting will be held Thursday, September 3rd at 7.00pm in the elementary media center. All NDPA parents are welcome to attend. Remember, unlike PTA, you are a member by being a part of the NDPA family. No dues or fees are required to be a part of it. So, come join us!

POET CHECK REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE

You will have a 30-day window in which to turn in any receipts after the purchase date. All receipts must be attached to a check reimbursement form (found on the bulletin board behind the POET desk in the elem. building) and the form must be filled out completely (i.e. sales tax, items purchased, etc.). The form must then be given to the POET board member over the event for which you made the purchase for their approval. Checks will only be written on Fridays. Look on the bulletin board behind the POET desk in the elem. building to find your reimbursement check the Friday (that school is in session) after it was submitted.

If you lose your check, you will be responsible to pay the stop payment fee in order for POET to re-issue the check.

POET PAYMENT POLICIES

Checks are preferred for payment to POET when purchasing anything through POET. If you are purchasing something through POET and are using cash, exact change is required. Any amount over the purchase price that is in cash will be considered a donation to POET.

There will be no refunds on events. Once tickets are purchased, if you are unable to attend, the money paid will be considered a donation to POET.

SCHOOL REWARDS

Did you know that you can help the school simply by shopping? NDPA participates in several incentive programs to earn rewards for much needed equipment and supplies. Some of the programs that we participate in are: *Albertson's Community Partners, Smith's Fresh Values Reward Card, Cell Phone recycling, Ink Cartridge recycling, Box Tops for Education, and Cream Weber lids.* There are drawers located next to the POET desk for the box tops, lids, cell phones, and ink cartridges. Simply have your student bring them in and deposit them into the correct drawer.

To enroll your shopping cards, pick up an Albertsons or Smith flyer with our code at the POET desk and next time you shop give the flyer along with your card to the clerk and they will do the rest.
