LOOKING AHEAD TO COOLER WEATHER:

As the fall temperature declines, we ask that students come prepared to school dressed for flexible weather temperatures and conditions. Layers are most helpful. Please remember that any coat, sweater, hat or glove can be worn outside of the school at recess etc. **HOWEVER**, with in the school, the uniform policy is required. Sweaters, sweatshirts, and any accessories must follow the guidelines outlined in the Family handbook.

As stated in the handbook:

- Socks must be ankle or knee length.
- Shoes must not be open-toed or backless.
- Jewelry and hair accessories need to be appropriate for school and not a distraction.
- Any sweaters worn inside the school must be consistent with the school uniform colors.
