We have partnered with a local Jiffy Lube who is helping organize food for families in need in our community through the Utah Food Bank. We would like to invite anyone interested in helping us by donating commercial canned food or other non-perishable items. There will be boxes in the front offices of each building for collection.

We will start collecting food Monday, November 17th and finish collecting Friday, November 21st. We will deliver the food to the Jiffy Lube location who will then "match" our donation.

At this time of economic hardship, we believe this is a great way to help build a positive relationship with our community. We have challenged the 4th graders to bring in two items each. We invite the rest of our school to step up with the 4th Grade in their efforts to help others in need. Together let's make this fantastic!

6th Grade Health Reminder:

To ensure that teens are adequately immunized, the Utah Immunization Program, along with Utah Schools, is participating in an immunization project called:

"Vaccinate Before You Graduate". This project is designed to help students be current on their shots **before** going to Jr. High School. The required shots are 1 Td booster and 2 Hep A Shots.

The goal at NDPA is to ensure that **all** our students are fully vaccinated against preventable diseases while they are still in school. This information should be provided to the school as soon as possible.

Yearbook News

This year with the Jr. High being added to our school, we have decided to have **1 yearbook for the K-6 grades and 1 yearbook for the Jr. High grades.** Flyers are being sent home for you to order them now. The K-6 book will cost \$13.00 and the Jr. High book will cost \$15.00. **Order now because these prices will only last until December 12th and then they will increase.** After December 12th the K-6 books will cost \$15.00 and the Jr. High books will cost \$18.00.

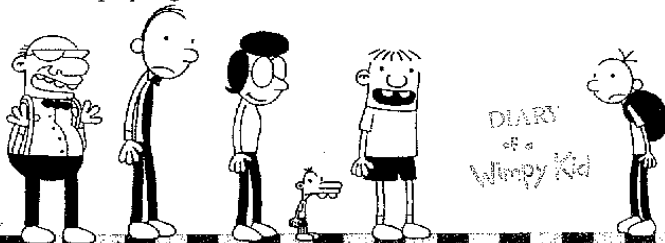
