Science Fair Judging - February 18th, 2010



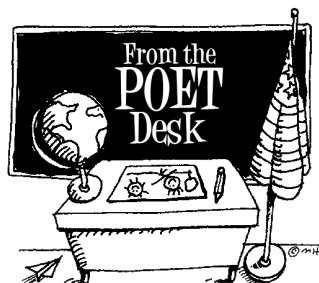

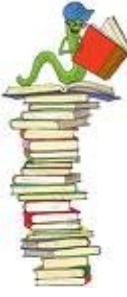


SCIENCE FAIR: "TIP of the WEEK"

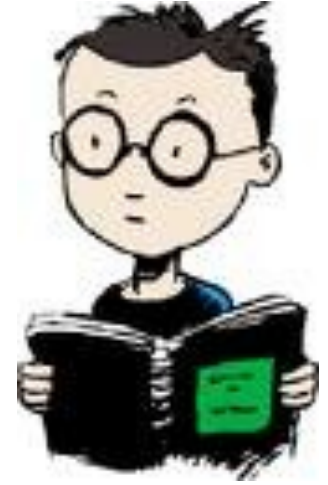
LAST DAY TO ORDER YOUR YEARBOOK IS DECEMBER 15th!!!
