Suggested School Supplies by Grade Level 2016-17

NOTICE: THE ITEMS ON THIS LIST WILL BE USED DURING THE REGULAR SCHOOL DAY. THEY MAY BE BROUGHT FROM HOME ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS; OTHERWISE, THEY WILL BE FURNISHED BY THE SCHOOL.

KINDERGARTEN

- Backpack:** should be brought to school daily and be large enough to carry crafts, library book, "show & tell" items, etc.
- Change of school uniform clothes:** Pants, shirt, and socks in a plastic bag with child's name on each item. (*Accidents can happen, wet weather and outside activities can affect the comfort of young children. It's great to have these on hand, "just in case."*)
- 1 Two-pocket folder with student name written on it**
- 1 Composition notebook with student name written on it**
- The following items will be shared as a class, please do not label:**
 - > Crayons (1 box) > Pencils (2, sharpened)
 - > Colored markers (1 box) > Pencil top erasers
 - > Scissors (1 pair) > Personal pencil sharpener (1)
 - > Glue sticks (8 sticks) > Colored Pencils (1 box, 24 count)

NOTE: Please only label the supplies as listed above.

We suggest you DO label all student coats, sweaters, hats, etc.
Class captains will email to request other supplies as needed.

1st Grade

- 1 SOLID color spiral notebook without perforation**
- 1 two-pocket folder**
- 2 composition notebooks**
- 1 pack 24 count crayons (no markers or colored pencils please)**
- 1 Crayola watercolor set, 8 count pan**
- 3 – 10 count packs of sharpened pencils (no designs please)**
- 15 glue sticks**
- 4 large pink erasers**
- 1 durable metal or heavy plastic magazine files**
- 1 container Clorox wipes**

All supplies will be shared with the class and labeled by the teacher.
We suggest you DO label all student coats, sweaters, hats, etc.

We will send notes home as supplies get low.*

- 1 box colored pencils, 24 count**
- 1 math graph composition notebook**
- 3 composition notebooks**
- 1 two-pocket folder**
- 8 Expo whiteboard markers**
- 2 pair scissors (Leave 1 pair at home in case the other gets lost.)**
- 6 glue sticks**
- 2 pkgs. erasable pens, different colors (Pilot FriXion Clicker are the best, the eraser never runs out!)**
- 1 box of markers**

NOTE: ALL ITEMS should be clearly marked with your student's name.

We also recommend you label all jackets, coats, etc.

4th Grade

CLASSROOM SUPPLIES (will be shared w/ class, DO NOT LABEL):

- 48 sharpened pencils**
- 24 pencil eraser caps**
- 1 ream lined paper**
- 8 glue sticks**
- 2 bottles liquid glue**
- 2 boxes facial tissues**

STUDENT PERSONAL SUPPLIES (please LABEL w/ name):

- Pencil pouch, filled with:**
 - > 4 pens, any color
 - > Pencil sharpener with shavings holder
- Spanish/English dictionary (optional)**
- 3 two-pocket folders**
- 7 spiral notebooks**
- 2" binder or accordion folder (optional)**

STUDENT SUPPLIES (kept in classroom, please LABEL w/ name):

- 1 magazine file (plastic, metal, or durable cardboard)**
- Pencil Box (to be kept in class) filled with:**
