## School Supply List by Grade Level 2019-20

Notice: the items on this list will be used during the regular school day. Items may be brought from home on a voluntary basis; otherwise, they will be provided by the school.

### KINDERGARTEN

Please LABEL with student's name:

- Backpack: large enough to carry projects, library book, binder, etc.
- Change of school uniform clothes: Pants, shirt, and socks in a plastic bag with child's name on each item. (Accidents can happen, wet weather and outside activities can affect the comfort of young children)
- 1 Two-pocket folder with student name written on it

Please DO NOT LABEL the following items (to be shared as a class):

- 1 box, 24 count, Crayola crayons (thin style, not thick)
- 12 pencils
- 1 box thick colored markers
- 1 box colored markers (thin style, not thick)
- Scissors
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 box, 12 count colored pencils

PLEASE LABEL all student coats, sweaters, hats, etc.

### 1<sup>st</sup> GRADE

Please bring the following to Back-to-School Night:

- 2 solid color spiral notebooks
- 1 composition book
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 magazine file (needs to be durable plastic or metal)
- 2 pack 24 crayons (please get the thin crayons)
- 8 sharpened pencils
- 5 glue sticks

DO NOT LABEL items with your child's name as they will be shared in class. We will be sending home notes as needed when supplies get low.

- 4 dry erase markers

STUDENT SUPPLIES (kept in classroom, please LABEL w/ name):

- 1 magazine file (metal or durable cardboard not bigger than 3 inches)

- 5 spiral notebooks (wide ruled)
- 1 flexible 1" plastic binder with rings
