Information 3 points:

You researched several different sources to become an “expert” on your topic.

How can I tell?

- Your information is accurate
- You summarized your information
- You analyzed your information and shared the most important parts

Interest 3 points:

You planned your presentation with the thought, “how can I help others learn about my topic?”

How can I tell?

- You thought about what others might want to know about your topic such as who, what, where, when, why, how.....and answered these during your presentation.
- You are happy and excited to share what you know
- You use your creativity to help engage your learners
- Your creativity does not take away from the content

Presentation 4 points:

Your presentation is refined.

- You memorized and practiced many times before submitting
- You do not have sentences or paragraphs on your PP slides (key words only)
- You maintained eye contact with the camera most of the time
- You are confident in sharing what you know
- Your presentation is not boring
