KINDERGARTEN

Please LABEL with student's name:

- Backpack:** large enough to carry projects, library book, binder, etc.
- Change of school uniform clothes:** Pants, shirt, and socks in a plastic bag with child's name on each item. (*Accidents can happen, wet weather and outside activities can affect the comfort of young children*)
- 1 Two-pocket folder with student name written on it**

1st GRADE
